RE: Important Calendar Changes Beginning July and August 2010

As part of the Court's ongoing effort to improve the use of courtroom facilities and judicial resources, changes affecting all divisions will be implemented on the dates indicated. Cases already scheduled to be heard after the effective dates of the changes described below will either remain on the date set or be moved with appropriate notice to a new date reflecting these changes.

- **Marina and Monterey Divisions**

Effective Tuesday, August 3, the Child Support Services calendar previously heard in Department 16 in Monterey will move to Department 21 in Marina where it will continue to be heard on Tuesdays by Commissioner Diana Baker. As a part of this change, Commissioner Baker will return to serving exclusively as the Title IV-D Commissioner, as she had from 1997 through 2005. (The Self-Represented Family Law and Motion calendar previously heard by Commissioner Baker will remain in the Monterey courthouse on Thursday mornings.)

Effective Thursday, August 5, the Small Claims calendar previously heard on Mondays in Department 16 in Monterey will move to Department 20 in Marina where it will be heard on Thursdays by Commissioner Christopher Martin. (The processing of Small Claims cases will remain in the Monterey division.)

- **Salinas and Marina Divisions**

Effective Tuesday, August 3, the Juvenile Truancy calendar previously heard in Department 20 in Marina will move to Department 11 in Salinas where it will be heard on Tuesdays by Judge Susan Dauphiné.

Effective Tuesday, August 3, the Deferred Entry of Judgment calendar previously heard on Mondays in Department 5 will be heard on Tuesdays in Department 5 by Judge Susan Matcham.

- **King City Division**

Effective Friday, July 2, 2010, the Traffic and Small Claims calendars previously heard in Department 19 on Thursdays will be heard in Department 18 on Fridays by Judge Albert Maldonado. (The processing of these cases will not change: Traffic processing will remain in the Marina division and Small Claims processing will remain in the Monterey division.)

Thank you for your attention to these significant changes in scheduling and location. We also appreciate your patience as we work to implement these changes as smoothly as possible.
