23.	NEW	15	15.06	Administrative and Traditional Writ of Mandamus Briefing Schedules and Page Limits. The applicable rule of Court (3.1113(d)) limits briefing to 15 pages without leave of court. Writ petitions nearly always require more, necessitating ex parte applications or stipulations to expand the page limit. Setting a higher limit in the form of a word count will significantly curtail the unnecessary use of judicial resources. As to scheduling, a consistent briefing schedule improves efficiency and both the Court and RA's ability to plan their calendars.
