## ATTENTION JURORS: Beware of Identity Theft Attempts

Courts in other counties and states have reported telephone scams by identity thieves targeting members of the public by claiming to be court employees needing personal and financial information to confirm jury service records.

THE COURT'S JURY SERVICES STAFF WILL NEVER ASK FOR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS, CREDIT CARD NUMBERS, BANK ACCOUNT NUMBERS OR OTHER CONFIDENTIAL AND SENSITIVE INFORMATION.

Although the Court has not been advised of this happening in Monterey County, you are urged to be aware of such scams and to be careful whenever you are asked to reveal personal information over the telephone.
