# **DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S TRUANCY ABATEMENT PROGRAM (TAP)**

California Ed.C. § 48200

Each person between the ages of 6 and 18 years not exempted . . . is subject to compulsory full-time education . . . [and] shall attend the public full-time day school or continuation school or classes and for the full time designated as the length of the school day . . .

California WIC §601.3

#### Authorization of the district attorney

Subsection (a): If the district attorney ...receives notice from the school district ...that a minor continues to be classified as a truant after the parents or guardians have been notified ... the district attorney ... may request the parents or guardians and the child to attend a meeting in the district attorney's office ... to discuss the possible legal consequences of the minor's truancy.

#### MONTEREY COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION

Provides formal truancy referral forms, created by District Attorney's TAP, to schools online; TAP training; provides alternative education programs

### **MONTEREY COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

Identify truant students, notify and meet with parents/guardians, refer to TAP.
